Suitable for application by boom spray, trickle, sprinkler, under tree jet or post harvest dip.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

AUS-CAL is a Liquid Calcium suitable for use where a readily available source of calcium is required. It is a form of soluble calcium for use in agricultural situations where nitrate is not required and the crop is tolerant to chloride. AUS-CAL assists root elongation and leaf development and assists in strengthening the plant structure. A deficiency in calcium can cause bitter pit in apples, the reduction of fruit firmness, lettuce tip burn, the reduction in storage life and tomato blossom end rot.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE.

Half fill spray tank then add compatible chemicals as required while agitating. Mix well. Add more water until the tank is full while maintaining agitation.

DO NOT STORE PRE-MIXED AUS-CAL WITH WATER OR OTHER CHEMICALS. MIX AND USE AUS-CAL AS REQUIRED.

COMPATIBILITY

AUS-CAL is compatible with most commonly used agricultural and horticultural products. Always check the label of the product to be mixed with AUS-CAL.

PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE, FISH, CRUSTACEA AND ENVIRONMENT

DO NOT contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with the chemical or used containers.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Store in the closed, original container in a well-ventilated area, as cool as possible. Do not store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight. Triple or preferably pressure rinse empty containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on-site. Break, crush, puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If not available, bury the containers below 500mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose, clear of waterways, vegetation and roots. Empty containers should not be burnt.
